National Summit, MSU team up on poll of economic issues

In the run-up to June, The National Summit will pair with Michigan State University to gather data and solicit opinions on pressing economic issues, said a statement released Wednesday by the summit's organizers.

The summit, convened by the Detroit Economic Club, will be held June 15-17 at Detroit's Ford Field and will deal with four key economic issues. The goal is to advance a national economic agenda, focusing on the four core areas of manufacturing, technology, energy and the environment. Forty-five speakers, most CEOs at companies across the nation, will speak at the event.
